Below are some ways you can help your child have their best year yet!

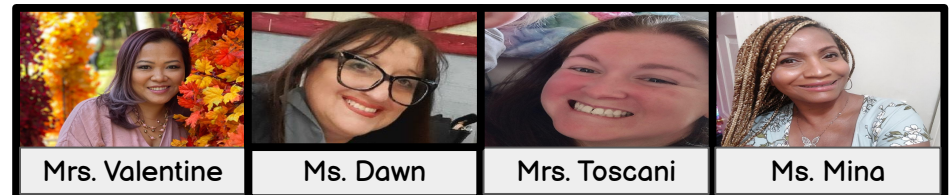
