Provide parents with reasonable access to staff.

In an effort to accommodate parents, teachers are available as early as 7:00am and as late as 5:00pm, with advance notice. Teachers are available to conference with parents during school hours. Parents are afforded the opportunity to have a telephone conference during evening hours and weekend hours.

Provide parents with opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:
